

**AGM SPEECH GIVEN BY DANIEL MORE AND RICHARD
HILLIER AGM**

IT IS NICE TO SEE SO MANY FAMILIAR FACES HERE AT OUR ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING TODAY. SO MANY FRIENDS, SO MANY LOYAL HELPERS! FAMILIAR FACES AND FRIENDSHIP IS THE TOPIC OF CHOICE I HAVE TAKEN TO START THIS SPEECH TONIGHT.

ME AND RICHARD RECENTLY ATTENDED ELLIE SHIELDS 16TH BIRTHDAY PARTY ... AND THE AMOUNT OF FAMILIAR STS FACES WAS BRILLIANT TO SEE YET AGAIN.

I WALKED ROUND BLUEWATER A COUPLE OF SATURDAYS BACK.... AND SAW 6 PEOPLE INVOLVED WITH STS AGAIN... FAMILIAR FACES.

OUR WEBSITE THAT WAS REVAMPED THIS YEAR... HAS SO FAR HAD 24000 VISITS! IN A YEAR... NEED I SAY MORE.

IN MY OPINION THIS MEANS THAT STAGE THEATRE SOCIETY IS DOING SOMETHING REALLY GOOD HERE.... KIDS AND ADULTS ALIKE ARE NOT ONLY COMING ALONG TO REHEARSALS... BUT THEY ARE MAKING LOTS OF FRIENDS AND FAMILIAR FACES ALONG THE WAY!

FOR MOST SHOWS THAT WE DO YOU GET TO KNOW THE FAMILIAR FACES THAT ARE GOING TO AUDITION FOR THEM. OUR RECENT PRODUCTION OF HAIRSPRAY SHOWED US THAT THESE FRIENDSHIPS ARE GOING STRONG... PEOPLE THAT WERE NOT GOING TO DO THE NEXT SHOW WERE NAGGED BY ALL OF THEIR FRIENDS TO DO THE SHOW AND THEN THEY AUDITIONED.

ALL OF US HERE CAN TAKE PLEASURE IN BEING PART OF THIS. CREATING A GROUP IN WHICH FRIENDSHIP AND FAMILIER FACES FLOURISH AND WILL CONTINUE TO GET STRONGER AND STRONGER AS STAGE THEATRE SOCIETY PROGRESSES FURTHER.

OVER THE LAST YEAR WE HAVE SEEN MANY SUCESSSES IN STAGE THEATRE SOCIETY. WE HAVE DONE THREE BRILLIANT SHOWS FOR EXAMPLE.

PETER PAN BACK IN MARCH WAS A GREAT SHOW... EVERYONE ENJOYED BEING PART OF THE PRODUCTION WHEN IT TOOK TO THE HAZLITT STAGE AND ALTHOUGH BEING A LITTLE BIT PANTOFIED IT WAS GREAT FUN TO DO!

WE THEN MOVE ON TO THE SPECTACULAR PRODUCTION (AND SPECTACULAR LIGHT SHOW) THAT WAS FOOTLOOSE! NO MATTER HOW HARD I TRIED I COULD NOT LEARN THAT BLOODY END DANCE - BUT THAT SHOW WAS AN ELECTRIC PERFORMANCE THAT I CAN SAFLY SAY THAT MYSELF AND EVERYONE INVOLVED TRULY ENJOYED!
